

#### (a) The entire decision

The Honourable Judges erred in failing and/or neglecting to having regards to European Law and ECHR provisions regarding the right to a fair trial and legal representation. This matter was commenced in summary proceedings when it should have been subject to full plenary proceedings.

The Learned Judges erred in failing and /or neglecting to have regard for the failure of the plaintiff to fully document their purported assignment of the loan & related securities to Fastnet 7. No supporting documentation surrounding the purported sale, namely No Trust Deed, Mortgage sale agreement, Servicing agreement or other ancillary documents to said Securitisation was ever produced by the plaintiff herein.

No supporting documentary evidence of any Alleged "repurchase" or de-securitise Notice has been produced by the plaintiff inter alia documents such as Notice to repurchase.

The learned judges erred in failing and /or neglecting to compel the plaintiff to produce the loan offer letter and related supporting documentation the subject matter of these proceedings. In the circumstances where the said facility/loan offer letter contains the plaintiffs alleged contractual right to pursue and proof of alleged debt owe by the defendants.

The learned judges erred in failing and /or neglecting to have regard for the fact the herein mortgage & charge was a tracker mortgage. The fact that the plaintiff have failed/refused and /or neglected to provide fully audited documented evidence in support of their bald assertion the everything was in order with regard to the accounting on the herein mortgage.
